CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF MICHAEL LEE STEIN

KELOWNA – The inquest into the death of Michael Lee Stein has been scheduled. While in the custody of Kelowna RCMP on Aug. 7, 2007, Mr. Stein became agitated and was taken to Kelowna General Hospital for medical attention. Despite medical treatment, he died on Aug. 16, 2007.

The inquest is scheduled for May 21-23, 2008. Presiding coroner Bruce Chamberlayne and a five-person jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
