Whereas a right-of-way for the Pacific Great Eastern
Railway Company is required over the lands described hereinafter
which said lands are within Tree Farm Licence Number 1;


Therefore pursuant to Clause 11 of the said Tree Farm
Licence, the following lands are temporarily withdrawn from the
lands designated in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence:

"All those unalienated and unencumbered Crown
lands occupied by the Pacific Great Eastern
Railway Co. for the purpose of clearing and
constructing a railroad right-of-way in a general
location as shown within those portions of the
bold black lines crossing the above mentioned
area, on the sketch attached hereto."

The lands are withdrawn for the period of time required to
clear and construct the said right-of-way. When final survey has
been completed, a permanent amendment will be prepared.

Reserving unto the Licensee of the said Tree Farm Licence
Number 1 any and all roads constructed by the Licensee.
