STREAM CLASSIFICATION

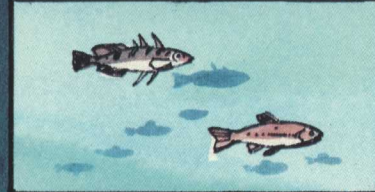
Class C streams (Color code: brown)

- No fish present
- Stream gradient usually greater than 20%
- Managed to protect downstream class A and B waters from accelerated debris and sediment transport



Steep gradient above
jam impassable

Resident sports fish
only above falls



Lakes

- Class A - Contain commercial and/or sports fish including resident sports fish
- Class B - Contain resident fish not currently designated as sports fish
- Class C - No fish resident

Class A Streams (Color code: red)

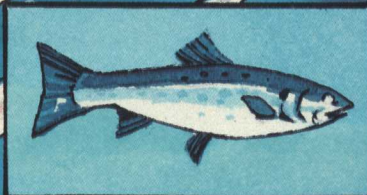
- Contain commercial and sports fish including resident sports fish, or streams identified for enhancement
- Stream gradient usually less than 12%
- Managed to maintain productive capacity of fish habitats
