In-season Modelling

The confidence of run strength modelling for steelhead increases as the season advances and catch data is collected at the Tyee test fishery¹. The dates below are milestones in the recommendation framework.

July 15 – Limited certainty in run strength

Aug 1 – Some certainty in run strength

Aug 15 – Greatest certainty – recommendation put forward as needed

Interim decision table recommendations are based on an Aug 15 deadline

Skeena Steelhead Recommendations Table

Skeena thresholds are identified in the Framework for Steelhead Management in BC² (Routine Management Zone; RMZ, Conservation Concern Zone; CCZ, Extreme Conservation Concern Zone; ECCZ).

Skeena – Adult summer steelhead carrying capacity (CC) 80,000

RMZ or Green = >30% of adult carrying capacity or 24,000 adult summer steelhead

CCZ or Yellow = 10% - 30% or 8,000 - 24,000

ECCZ or Red = <10% or <8,000

Extreme Conservation Concern (ECCZ) <10% CC; 8,000 or less	 Recommend closure of steelhead angling Angling remains open to other species Request bait ban mirror order from DFO Closure may extend into spring season based on final estimate Implement 2 weeks (14d) after statutory decision
Extreme Conservation Concern (ECCZ) <5% CC; 4,000 or less	 Recommend full angling closure Request to DFO to mirror freshwater closures Closures to extend into spring of next year Implement 2 weeks (14d) after statutory decision
