## FLEET PRO BEST PRACTICES

Here's some ways to support your drivers (even if you've been instructed to work remotely):

- Monitor status of COVID-19 in areas of high driver volume and ensure all drivers have your current contact information
- Make sure vehicles are stocked with disinfecting supplies such as hand sanitizer, wipes, and surface cleaners
- Visit <u>ARI's COVID-19 resource center</u> to monitor updates
- Monitor vehicle health to avoid breakdowns or emergencies by staying consistent with preventative maintenance and monitoring telematics when applicable
- Schedule repair appointments with enough time to disinfect vehicle; ensure drivers and technicians practice social distancing

## **ON-THE-ROAD PREVENTION TIPS**

Here are some ways drivers can help limit transmission when delivering essential services:	
Disinfect surfaces of shared vehicles and/or equipment before and after using	
Practice social distancing measures with customers or other drivers	
Confirm you have hand sanitizer in your vehicle that complies with health guidelines	
Follow recommended sanitizing and distancing measures when refueling vehicles	
Keep your vehicle neat and limit the items going in and out with you
