IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 19
AMENDMENT NO. 12

Whereas part of Lot 595 Nootka Land District, said to contain 2.81 acres, is within Tree Farm Licence Number 19 and is found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of timber;

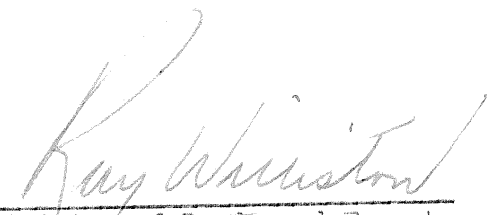
And whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands in no way affects the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence.

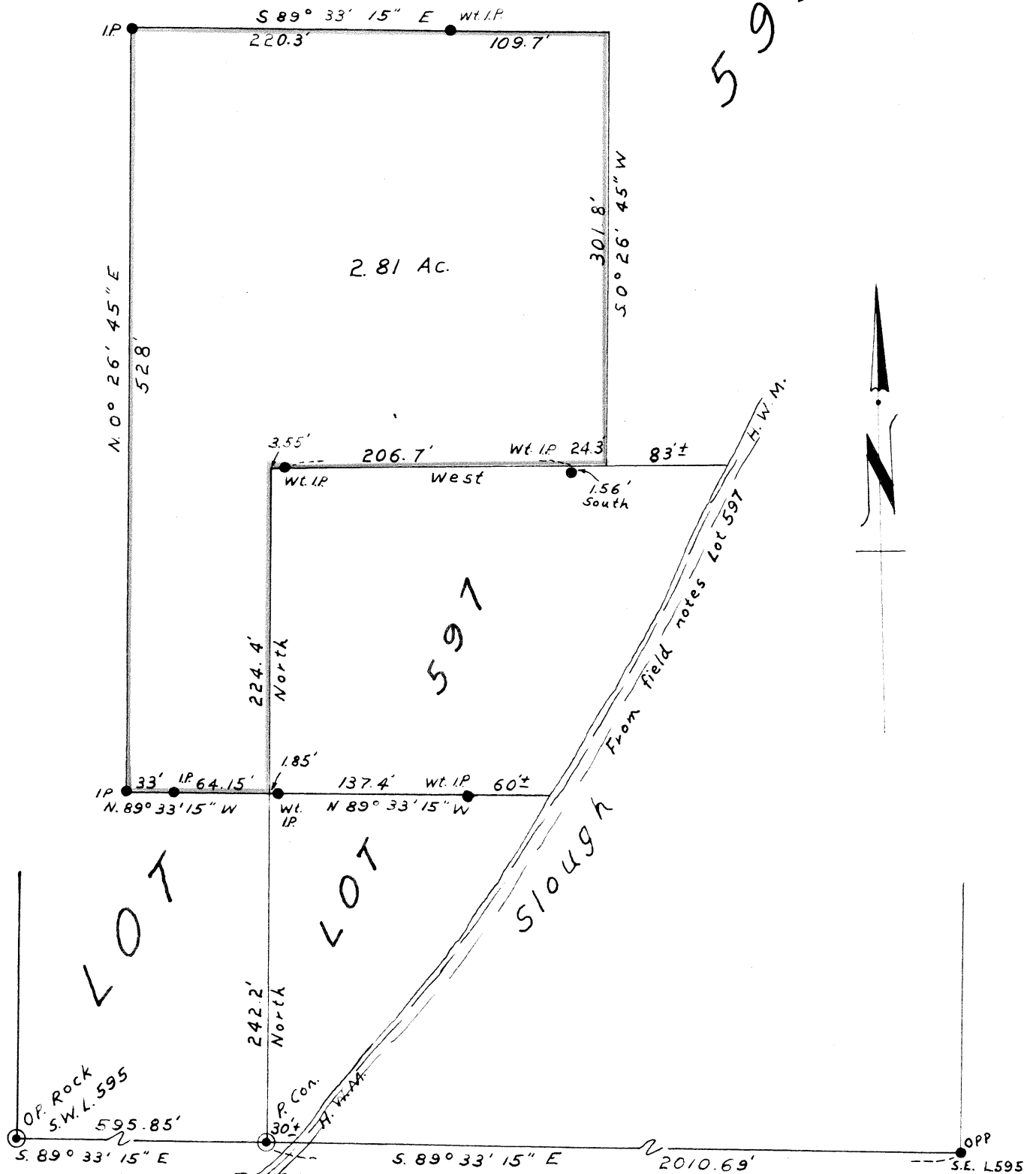
Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the "Forest Act" being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1960 and Clause 12 of the said Tree Farm Licence, the Licensor hereby consents to the following lands being withdrawn from the said Tree Farm Licence being that part of Lot 595 Nootka Land District described as follows:

"Commencing at a point on the West boundary of Lot 597, Nootka District, distant Northerly from the Southwest corner thereof 242.20 feet; thence Westerly and at right angles to said West boundary of Lot 597, 99.00 feet; thence Northerly and at right angles to the last mentioned course, 528.00 feet; thence Easterly and at right angles to last mentioned course, 330.00 feet; thence Southerly and at right angles to last mentioned course, 303.60 feet, more or less, to an intersection with the Northerly boundary of the aforesaid Lot 597; thence Westerly and following the said North boundary of Lot 597, 231.00 feet, more or less, to the Northwest corner of said Lot 597; thence Southerly and following said West boundary of Lot 597, 224.4 feet, more or less, to point of commencement and containing 2.81 acres, more or less, as shown outlined in red on the attached plan.

and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence.
