Continuous Improvement Cycles

A continuous improvement cycle is a critical element of the ongoing commitment to raising system performance. Continuous improvement cycles are developed by the district and ensure a focus on the educational success of all students and effective and efficient school district operations.

The annual reporting process is an element of the continuous improvement cycle. Within a cycle, districts review and analyze data and evidence to identify and implement operational adjustments, adaptations, and next steps. The Enhancing Student Learning Report summarizes this analyzed data for the public and allows a yearly touchpoint for the district to **review**, **reflect**, and **plan**, between iterations of the long-term strategic plan, to help establish and maintain robust planning cycles that continuously improve student learning.

A comprehensive approach to a continuous improvement cycle includes:

- Reviewing, analyzing, monitoring, interpreting, and reflecting on the district's educational outcomes;
- Reviewing, analyzing, monitoring, and reflecting on the district's strategies intended to improve student success and address inequities in student learning;
- Actively collaborating with local First Nations;
- Actively engaging with Indigenous communities and organizations, including Métis and Inuit; and with other education partners; and
- Aligning district operational plans to implement the adjusted plan based on findings that emerged from data and evidence analysis and engagement with all education partners.






