
Buy an Initiation Hunting Licence for Yourself



What is this licence for?	An Initiation hunting licence is a mentoring licence that allows a B.C. resident, 18 years of age or older, to hunt. A person who holds an initiation licence must be accompanied by and under close supersion of a qualified supervising adult.
Who can buy this licence?	B.C. resident adults (18 or older) who have never held a B.C. hunting licence (with the exception of a Youth licence). This licence can only be purchased once, and is good for one licence year.





Before you start

Before you buy your initiation hunting licence, make sure you have:

- A verified, active Fish and Wildlife ID
- An active BC Resident credential
- Credit card for payment

Then click **Buy Licences** under the **Licences** lefthand menu item, or from the top banner on your Fish and Wildlife profile.



NOTE: You can download or print the Supervising form now or later, from www.gov.bc.ca/hunting (click Forms in the left hand menu).

You must have the supervising form with you while hunting.


Choose Initiation licence

- Click Form (Link) to Download or print the Supervisor form (to be carried with you while hunting)



Pay and finish

- You can review details about the licence or click View Receipt

NOTE: Initiation licences are electronic and **do not need to be printed.** Hunters aged 16 and over must carry photo ID to
present to an officer on request.
