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**DISMISSAL ORDER**

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WHEREAS:

- A. On April 18, 2018 the complainants, Konrad and Catherine Pimiskern, filed a complaint under Section 3 of the *Farm Practices Protection (Right to Farm) Act* (“*the FPPA*”) with respect to flooding generated by a neighbouring sweet cherry orchard farm.
- B. In an email dated April 28, 2020 the complainant, Konrad Pimiskern, signed a Notice of Withdrawal dated for reference April 23, 2020, confirming withdrawal of the complaint.
- C. Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, S.B.C. 2004, c. 45 provides that where the complainant has withdrawn all or part of the complaint, the tribunal must order the complaint dismissed.

THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:

1. That the complaint filed by Konrad and Catherine Pimiskern is dismissed.
