CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF WILLIAM COREY DELORME

NANAIMO – The inquest into the death of William Corey Delorme has been scheduled. On Dec. 6, 2007, Mr. Delorme was found unresponsive at his residence. Emergency medical services attended and his death was pronounced at the scene.

The inquest is scheduled for Feb. 2-5, 2010. Presiding coroner Rose Stanton and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
