BURNABY – The BC Coroners Service will hold a public inquest into the death of Charles Henry Engelbert.

Mr. Engelbert died on April 17, 2010, one day after being critically injured while falling trees on a forestry worksite in a remote area near Likely.

Presiding coroner Tom Pawlowski and a jury will hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses to determine the facts surrounding this death. While the jury may not, by law, make any findings of legal responsibility, it will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.

An inquest is a formal process that allows for public presentation of evidence relating to a death.
