Recent purchase of two new fuel-efficient school buses to replace two outdated models.

C. Paper Consumption

- Reducing paper consumption by shifting to digital forms and storage wherever possible.
- Currently investigating a new component to our payroll system which would greatly reduce paper consumption.
- Seek supplier able to provide paper with a higher percentage of recycled content
