Re: Cruise Based Billing Procedures (2016)

Interior HBS Area Based Billing Procedures – Phase II (2016)

The purpose of the memo is to inform you that the updated *Cruise Based Billing Procedures* and the *Interior HBS Area Based Billing Procedures* are effective for May 2016 area based billing.

The procedures are implemented in the Harvest Billing System (HBS) to simplify the electronic cruise based billing transactions between industry and government and to address the timing of area based billing submissions.

As before, clients that will be entering areas cut will require a Cruise Based Administrator (CBA) role in HBS. The licensee and timber mark must be associated with the CBA user role.
