Passenger Transportation Services in B.C. now provided through CVSE's Commercial Passenger Vehicle Program

We are pleased to advise that the ministry's Commercial Vehicle Safety & Enforcement (CVSE) Branch recently became the new home of provincial government Passenger Transportation services in B.C.

The decision to incorporate Passenger Transportation under CVSE's banner was made to combine and leverage the resources, knowledge, and parallel functions of the two branches to the benefit of our staff, stakeholders, the public, and the industries we serve.

While there is no longer a Passenger Transportation Branch, the same staff who previously supported your licensing and registration needs now operate within CVSE's Commercial Passenger Vehicle (CPV) Program and will continue to do so. No services have been, or will be, interrupted as a result of this change.

Where our Passenger Transportation Enforcement Officers (PTEOs) have always collaborated with their CVSE counterparts, they are now even more closely aligned in their work to continue regulating the Passenger Transportation Industry from within the same branch.

Our forms and web pages are in the process of being updated to reflect the new placement of Passenger Transportation services within the CVSE framework and this work will continue over the coming weeks.
