Executive Summary

As part of its overall long-term Strategic Plan, the Conseil Scolaire Francophone recognizes the importance that all environmental learning aims to integrate environmental thinking and ideas into students' everyday lives. In this way, it is hoped students will begin to realize how they can take personal responsibility and leadership in creating a more environmentally sustainable way of life. We must also turn to ourselves as an educational institution and as individuals to make changes and develop a new ethic - a responsible attitude toward caring for the Earth. Working to integrate environmental learning within all subject areas promotes this change in attitude by providing students with opportunities to experience and investigate the relationships linking individuals, societies, and natural surroundings. Through its Capital Program, the CSF practices environmental sustainability as demonstrated by the LEEDS Silver designation granted to École Victor Brodeur. The CFS new secondary school Jules Verne, recently opened in January 2009 is expected to receive LEEDS Silver certification. Two future construction projects in Campbell River and Comox areas will be LEEDS Gold certified. The CSF has established a Green Team committee which will be mandated to coordinate and support all aspects of helping students and the community to learn about how they are connected to natural environment through direct experience in both natural and human designed systems like their school buildings.
