SUSPENSION of Free Miner Certificate: Section 10(2) of the Mineral Tenure Act

NOTICE: Section 18(4) of the Mineral Tenure Act

Dear Apogee Gold Corporation:

On October 2nd 2019, Mines Inspector Grant Feldinger conducted an inspection of mine number 1621367 located on placer lease 1051023.

On October 8, 2019, you were provided a copy of the inspection report and notice of my intention to cancel your Free Miner Certificate. Since this time, you have not requested a hearing and have not responded to the notice. You have also failed to satisfy the conditions of *Mines Act* permit P-4-411 and have failed to reclaim mine number 1621367.

The letter is to inform you of my decision to suspend your Free Miner Certificate for an indefinite period of time. You may only renew your Free Miner Certificate on any terms and conditions the Chief Gold Commissioner may impose at the time.

Pursuant to Section 18(4) of the Mineral Tenure Act, this letter serves as notice that I am considering cancelling your placer claim numbers 805202, 1039040, 1039042, 1039046, 1039047, 1039052, 1039054, 1039055, 1039345, 1039346, 1039347, 1039348, and 1039349.

If I have not heard from you within 30 days of service, I may proceed to cancel these claims by order pursuant to Section 18(4) of the *Mineral Tenure Act*.
