Notice of Rescission of a Permission to Use/Occupy Crown Land

ATTENTION:

Dana Desiree FOSTER

and

Stephen George LUDWIG

and

SNOWY MOUNTAIN; SNOWY MOUNTAIN ALPINE TOURS; SNOWY MOUNTAIN LODGE; and NORTH BLUE LODGE (together, "SML").

The Minister of Forests (the "Minister") is responsible for the management of most Crown land in British Columbia, under the authority of the *Land Act* RSBC 1996 Ch. 245.

Access to Crown land may be had through the issuance of tenures under the *Land Act*, or through a permission granted by the Minister to members of the public under the Permission Policy. The permission to use Crown land is a bare licence which may be limited or rescinded to a greater or lesser extent, from place to place, and from time to time.

The Minister is rescinding permission for <u>SML</u>, <u>Dana Foster</u>, and <u>Stephen Ludwig</u> to be on Crown land for the purpose of outdoor recreation, whether personal or commercial, including but not limited to:

- backcountry skiing and hiking;
- the use of snowmobiles and all terrain vehicles;
- the storage of tools, building materials, recreation equipment and other belongings; and
- the construction of improvements

within the area outlined in bold black line on the attached map. This rescission is effective on March 24, 2023, and expires on March 24, 2024.

Use and occupation of Crown land without lawful authority is contrary to the *Land Act* and is trespass, the consequence of which may be administrative remedies or trespass charges under s. 59 and 60 of the *Land Act*.


