## **Executive Summary**

Knowledge Network Corporation's Carbon Neutral Action Report was prepared in accordance with the *Greenhouse Gas Reduction Targets Act* adopted in November 2007 by the Ministry of Environment's Climate Action Secretariat. As British Columbia's viewer supported public broadcaster, it reflects our ongoing commitments to act responsibly on the environment and to increase awareness of environmental and climate change issues with our viewers across the province.

To reduce our greenhouse gas emissions in 2012, we continued efforts to reduce post-consumer recycled paper usage and consumption resulting in a 7.9% decrease from the previous year. Overall Knowledge Network has reduced its paper consumption by 29.8% since reporting began in 2009.

Knowledge Network staff led an important initiative to remove old video tapes stored at our facility. Over the course of three months staff dismantled and recycled approximately 2000 video tapes.

As a tenant in a building owned and operated by the British Columbia Institute of Technology, building operations are beyond our control.

Knowledge Network Corporation's 2013 climate change action plans focus primarily on educational broadcast initiatives that influence behavioural change. Our greatest impact continues to be with our public broadcast service, both on-air and online at Knowledge.ca and KnowledgeKids.ca. Programs broadcast in 2012 include: Architects of Change, To Make A Farm, Who Killed the Electronic Car?, Dirt! The Movie, Secrets of the Emerald Sea, Rapidly Changing Artic, Blue Planet, Planet Earth, Water on the Table and Earth Days. With an average weekly reach of 1.4 million viewers, Knowledge Network is well positioned to educate British Columbians about the issues of climate change, conservation and sustainability. We are committed to researching and acquiring content in these areas that will engage audiences across the province.

## **Emission Reduction Activities**

Actions Taken to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in 2012:

- Dismantled and recycled approximately 2000 video tapes
- Reduced consumption of paper by 7.9% over last year.
- Purchased paper containing 30% recycled content.
- Educated viewers by broadcasting documentary series to educate viewers on climate change and the conservation of water, energy and raw materials.
- Implemented on-going communications to engage staff.

Plans to Continue Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions 2013 - 2015

- Broadcast content delivery will transition from physical tape to electronic files for editing, close captioning and dubbing.
- We will continue to educate British Columbians through the broadcast of documentary series on issues of climate change, conservation and sustainability.


