

Wildfire Information Document

Before March 1 of each year, a person who, under the *Forest Act*, is the holder of (a) a major forest licence, (b) a <u>timber sale licence</u> that is not a major licence, (c) a community forest agreement, or (d) a woodlot licence must provide an official with a 24 hour a day contact telephone number if the person proposes to carry out an industrial activity on or after March 1 and before November 1 of that year
