

## PRESENT:



The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:
The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Cariboo Mining Division, Caribou Land District:

Commencing at a point on the southeast corner of GMM No. 122 mineral claim, Record No. 50771 , said point being S. $70^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ E. a distance of 11,600 feet more or less from the most easterly corner of Lot 3730:


thence S. $45^{\circ} 25^{\prime}$ W., a distance of 590 feet;
thence S. $44^{\circ} 35^{\prime}$ E., a distance of 2,900 feet;
thence N. $01^{\circ} 05^{\prime}$ W., a distance of 2,050 feet; thence N. $88^{\circ} 55^{\prime}$ E., a distance of 1,500 feet; thence S. $01^{\circ} 00^{\prime}$ E., a distance of 3,016 feet; thence S. $88^{\circ} 35^{\prime}$ E., a distance of 4,470 feet; thence S. $01^{\circ} 50^{\prime} \mathrm{W}$., a distance of 3,000 feet, more or less to the point of commencement, and containing approximately 6,972 acres.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
