EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 23, APR 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Kamloops Mining Division, Kamloops Division of Yale Land District, in the period commencing on the date of approval of this Order and terminating March 1st, 1976:

> The Stein River drainage and that portion of the Kwoiek Creek drainage upstream from a point 366 chains west and 35 chains north of the southeast corner of Indian Reserve 7 (Nahamanak), save and excepting thereout Indian Reserve 9 (Stryen), and Indian Reserve 9B (Lytton):

and

On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location during the aforementioned period, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
