
Flowchart for determining when LCA categories adopt brand reference prices from other jurisdictions



The point at which an LCA category becomes part of the TPF⁺. Once an LCA category becomes part of the TPF, the drugs within that category retain TPF status irrespective of any exit/entry of other drugs within the same category.

[•] Was established before April 1, 2014 and a generic drug was added or removed on or after April 1, 2014 but before Ápril 1, 2019



[†]TPF stands for Tiered Pricing Framework. An LCA category is part of the TPF if it:

[•] Was established on or after April 1, 2014; or

[•] Has experienced the addition or removal of a generic drug on or after April 1, 2019; or
