Technical Details

Dell Avamar, Dell NetWorker Virtual Edition (NVE) and Dell PowerProtect DP Series Appliance /Integrated Data Protection Appliance (IDPA) remediation is available for multiple vulnerabilities that could be exploited by malicious users to compromise the affected system

These vulnerabilities are rated as an overall High Severity.

- Ensure mitigation is performed at your next change window.
