

Beverage Container Stewardship Program Regulation Annual Report by the Director

2001 Reporting Period

Synopsis

The regulation encompasses all containers of ready-to-drink beverages, except for milk, milk substitutes, infant formula and meal replacements. The regulation requires a seller of beverages to collect a deposit from the purchase, specifies the minimum amount of the deposit and requires seller and/or depots to accept containers and pay a refund per container not less than the amount of the deposit collected. Containers are managed in accordance with three stewardship plans approved under the regulation. The stewardship plans are required to show how an 85% recovery rate will be achieved within 2 years after the implementation date for the plan. In 2001, the overall recovery rate was unchanged from 2000, at 81%

Program Performance

Stewardship Agencies

The three stewardship agencies established by the beverage industry to meet their responsibilities under the regulation are

Encorp Pacific (Canada), responsible for non-alcoholic beverages, representing 55% of total containers
Liquor Distribution Branch, responsible for wine, spirits, non-refillable beer, cider and coolers, other than those produced by Molson and Labatt, representing 8% of total containers, and
Brewers Distributors Ltd., responsible for domestic beer in refillable glass bottles and aluminum cans, representing 37% of total containers.

Financial Information and Overall Recovery Rate

Funding for the management of containers is generated through unredeemed deposits, revenue from sales of recyclable materials and for some containers, brand-owner fees. The following independently audited financial and recovery rate information has been provided by the industry stewards:

Container Management

Encorp Pacific (Canada)

Information on the processing of containers and the marketing of the recyclable product is contained in the 2001 Annual Report on Encorp's website.

Liquor Distribution Branch

Under an agreement with the Liquor Distribution Branch, Encorp Pacific (Canada) recycles containers in the Liquor Distribution Branch stewardship plan. Information on the processing of containers and the marketing of the recyclable product is contained in Encorp's Annual Report on its website..

Brewers Distributors Ltd.

Glass bottles are refilled on average 15 times each. Glass which is unsuitable for refilling is crushed at Pacific Metals and sent to glass bottle manufacturers in Washington, Oregon and California in the manufacture of new containers and other materials. Approximately 335,972 pounds of refillable glass was processed for recycling.

Aluminum is crushed and shipped by rail to ALCOA for recycling. Over 6000 tonnes of aluminum is recycled annually into products such as new aluminum cans and other fabricated aluminum products.

The Beverage Container Management Board (BCMB)

The BCMB meets at least on quarterly basis or more often as needed, and provides advice to the Minister on the deposit-refund system in particular and beverage container program issues in general. The ten member board comprises representatives nominated by the three industry stewards, the BC Bottle Depot Association, Union of BC Municipalities, labour, retail grocers, Recycling Council of BC, and environmental non-government organization and the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection. The Board is chaired by John Nixon, representing Encorp Pacific (Canada).
