- Additional delivery information is optional data that a mailer wishes to include. (title, floor, branch, municipal address, etc.). It is always placed above the municipal/post office box address.
- The postal box number should always be placed on the line just above the municipality, province and Postal Code. The # symbol should not be used. Punctuation should not be used.
- Station information should be present to direct mail to the proper postal installation when there is more than one installation within a municipality.

- The official municipality name, as provided to Canada Post.
- The **province** should always be presented using the recognized twoletter symbol.
- The Postal Code should be in upper case and placed two spaces to the right of the province with one space between the first three and last three characters.
