THIS AGREEMENT is made effective the 18^{th} day of June, 2014.

BETWEEN:

THE MINISTER OF FORESTS LANDS AND NATURAL RESOURCE OPERATIONS, on behalf of HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA Parliament Buildings Victoria, British Columbia V8V 1X4

(the "Minister")

AND:

COAST TSIMSHIAN RESOURCES LIMITED PARTNERSHIP 4905 Keith Avenue Terrace, BC V8G 4B1

(the "Licensee")

WHEREAS:

- A. Ministry of Aboriginal Relations and Reconciliation and the Kitsumkalum First Nations have identified an area of Tree Farm Licence 1 that is of significant interest to the Kitsumkalum First Nations.
- B. In accordance with the *Forest Act*, the Minister and Licensee entered into a replacement agreement for Tree Farm Licence 1 dated January 1, 2008.
- C. The Licensee provided consent for this deletion in the attached letter of agreement signed on July 13, 2012, to facilitate the Interim Treaty Agreement with Kitsumkalum First Nations.

THEREFORE:

In accordance with Section 39.1(1) of the *Forest Act*, the Minister, with the consent of the Licensee, amends the area of Tree Farm Licence 1 by deleting the area identified on the Instrument 104 map.

The Minister and the Licensee agree that Schedule B of Tree Farm Licence 1 is hereby amended to reflect the land deletion of 18.7 hectares as described above.

In accordance with the *Allowable Annual Cut Administration Regulation*, the deletion described above reduces the Allowable Annual Cut of Tree Farm Licence 1 by 0 m³/year.

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

Dear Mr. Lawrence,

Thank you for taking the time to meet with Phil Symington and me on Friday, May 18, 2012, in which we discussed the current status of treaty negotiations with the Kitsumkalum First Nation (Kitsumkalum). I found our meeting and exchange of information very constructive and helpful.

During our discussions, we expressed the Province's interest in transferring the parcel of land identified in red on the attached map to Kitsumkalum. The parcel falls within the proposed Kitsumkalum treaty settlement land package and is proposed for early transfer in fee simple to Kitsumkalum as part of an Incremental Treaty Agreement (ITA) aimed at fostering economic development. As we noted in the meeting, a portion of that parcel lies within your client, Coast Tsimshian Resource's (CTR) Tree Farm Licence 1 (TFL 1). The Province wishes to delete this area from TFL 1 to facilitate the early transfer of these lands to Kitsumkalum. We are hopeful that the Kitsumkalum ITA will be signed shortly and we would like to begin the preparations for transfer of the lands in fee simple as soon as possible after signing.

In our meeting, you offered to seek CTR's consent to the removal of this parcel from TFL 1 on the understanding that compensation for this deletion would be addressed at treaty effective date as part of compensation that may be payable to CTR for the impacts of the treaty. CTR's consent would facilitate the timely transfer of this land by negating the need for Minister Polak to provide one year's prior notice for the deletion under section 60.5 of the *Forest Act*.

I confirm the Province's interest in pursuing this small deletion from CTR's TFL 1 and respectfully request that you seek CTR's consent to this deletion. If CTR concurs, I ask that both you and a representative of CTR sign this letter in the space provided below. By signing this letter, CTR will be agreeing that it provides consent under section 39.1 of the *Forest Act* to the Minister of Forests, Lands, and Natural Resource Operations to amend TFL 1 to delete the area identified in red on the attached map.


