Re: Draft Policy and supporting documents regarding issuance of Free Use Permits (FUPs) for First Nations domestic use of Crown timber

Please find attached the draft (interim) policy and supporting documents that have been developed to assist staff when consulting with or receiving requests from First Nations for FUPs.

In 2006, the Supreme Court of Canada issued the *Sappier* and *Gray* decisions recognizing an aboriginal right to harvest timber for domestic purposes on Crown lands including the construction of residential dwellings. Since these decisions were made, the *Forest Act* and the Free Use Permit Regulation has been amended to facilitate the use of Crown timber by First Nations for traditional and cultural activity including domestic purposes.

In 2009, a FUP steering committee was established with representation from Operations and Tenure and Revenue Divisions to develop a draft (interim) policy and supporting material to provide advice and guidance to staff when considering issuing a FUP to a First Nation for a traditional and cultural activity or for domestic use (construction of a residential dwelling).

The draft (interim) policy and supporting material were presented to and approved by the Operations Leadership Team in January, 2010. The policy and supporting material is now available for distribution to staff who may be involved in First Nation consultation processes or who may receive First Nation requests for FUPs.

The policy is being distributed in draft (interim) form at this time in order to provide the necessary advice and guidance to staff as quickly as possible. The policy and supporting material may be adjusted in the future if needed.
