EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 22. SEP. 1977

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that no person shall locate upon and no free miner shall stake on or acquire a location in or upon, the following described lands in the Fort Steele Mining Division, Kootenay Land District:

An area 4 km wide, being 2 km on each side of the centre line of the right-of-way for the proposed Elco Mining Limited railway and road, as shown on Map 1 Volume 449 File 113, in the office of the Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Mines and Petroleum Resources, Victoria, British Columbia; which lands are hereby designated as placer reserves under the Placer Mining Act,

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. No holder of a mineral claim or lease issued under the Mineral or Placer Mining Acts that may be hereafter located within the area outlined above shall be entitled to any surface rights in that area used by Elco Mining Limited, its successors and assigns as a right-of-way for the construction, operation and maintenance of a road, railway or powerline, or as the site of a structure of any kind, or for the construction of the road, railway, powerline or structure of any kind, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim or lease as a result of such construction.
- 2. No holder of a mineral claim or lease issued under the Mineral and Placer Mining Acts that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above or any person exploring, developing, mining or working in any way the said mineral claim or lease shall be entitled to any claim for damage which may be caused by any construction, operation and maintenance of a railway bed, road or powerline or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim or lease as a result of such construction.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT upon expiry of any mineral claim or lease which lies within the area outlined above, the lands covered by any such mineral claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.
