3.2.1 Step-by-Step Log Volume Calculation instructions	Step 3 #3: Insect damage . Spruce trees in all maturity classes with insect damage code 7 will be moved to the highest mature risk group. This means all insect damage code 7 trees in FIZ's A,B and C will move to risk group 2 and all insect damage code 7 trees in FIZ's D-L will move to mature risk group 3.
3.2.1 Step-by-Step Log Volume Calculation Instructions	Step 3 #3: Fire damage . Remove any risk group changes for fire damage codes.
3.2.1 Step-by-Step Log Volume Calculation instructions	Step 4: Fire damage : A new breakage table added that will apply an additional breakage allowance to all trees with fire damage code A (0%), code B (5%), and code C (40%). Maximum DWB for any tree is 100%.
4.2 Damage Report Calculation	Example of multiple damage codes is revised.
