AMENDMENT NUMBER 9



Whereas Lot 2247, Rupert Land District is within Tree Farm Licence Number 37 and is found to be suitable for a higher economic use than the growing of forest crops;

And whereas the withdrawal of this lot will have little effect on the sustained yield management of the said Tree Farm Licence;

Therefore pursuant to Subsection (14) of Section 36 of the Forest Act being Chapter 153 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, and pursuant to Clause 10 of the said Tree Farm Licence, Lot 2247, Rupert Land District which is shown outlined in bold black on the sketch attached hereto is herewith withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence and the lot so withdrawn is and shall be henceforth no longer part of or subject to the said Tree Farm Licence Number 37.

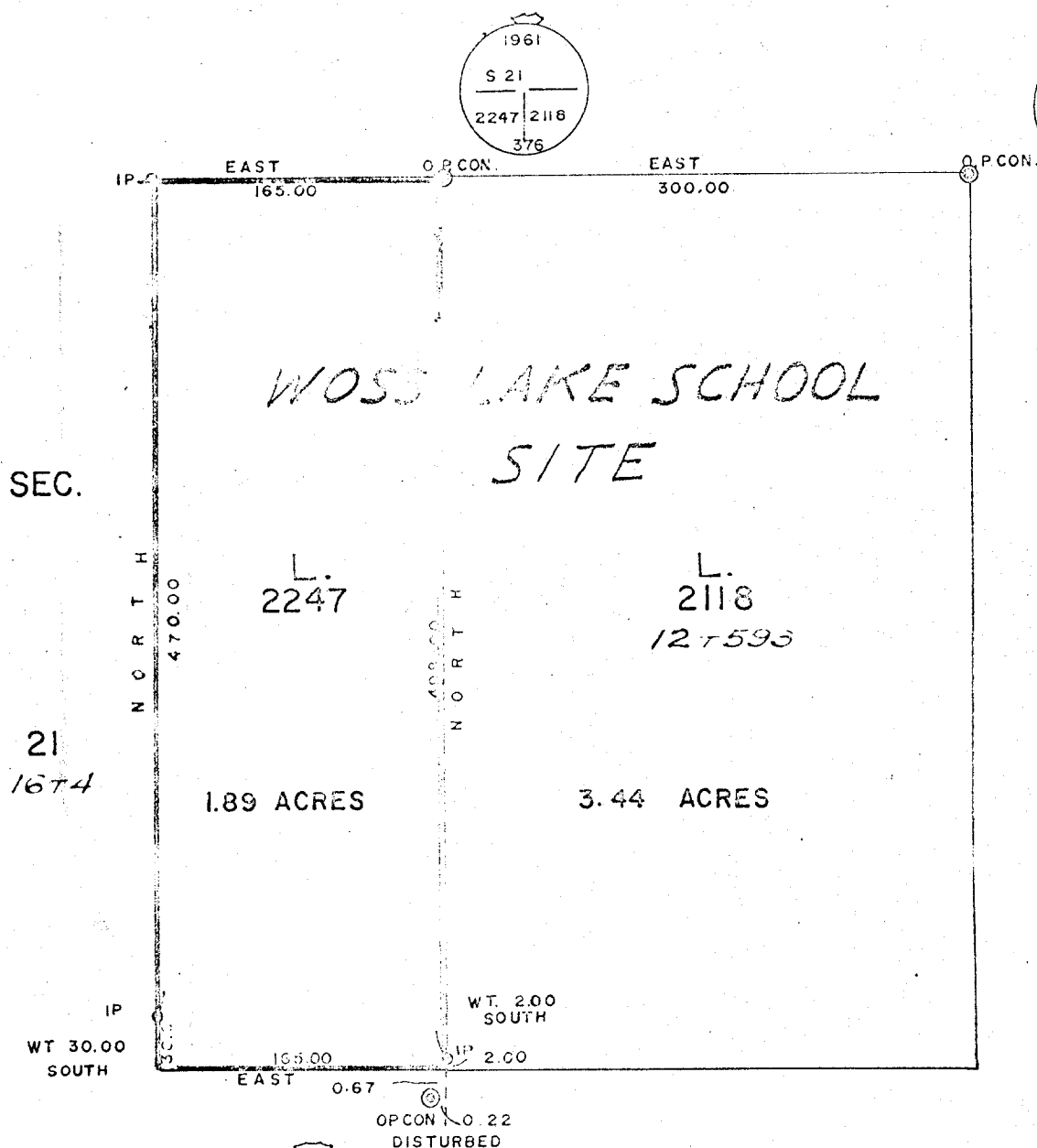
