EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 001.29.1980

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the following described areas be and are hereby designated as designated placer land.

- (1) All that portion of the watershed of Quartz Creek upstream of the intersection of the natural boundary of Heather Creek on the left bank thereof with the natural boundary of Quartz Creek on the left bank thereof, in the Golden Mining Division, Kootenay Land District.
- (2) All the area in the Omineca Mining Division, Cassiar Land District, commencing at the point of intersection of the natural boundary of the Toodoggone River on the left bank thereof with the natural boundary of Katherine Creek on the right bank thereof; thence northwesterly in a straight line 8 000 m, more or less, to the summit of Toodoggone Peak; thence continuing northwesterly in a straight line 13 200 m, more or less, to the summit of Oxide Peak; thence southwesterly in a straight line 12 500 m, more or less, to the point of intersection of the natural boundary of Toodoggone River on the left bank thereof with the natural boundary of Moosehorn Creek on the left bank thereof; thence S 8° E 12 500 m; thence S 75° E 6 000 m; thence northeasterly in a straight line 24 000 m, more or less, to the aforesaid point of intersection of the Toodoggone River with Katherine Creek, being the point of commencement.
