Declaration statement: This PSO Climate Change Accountability Report for the period January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 summarizes our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions profile, the total offsets to reach net-zero emissions, the actions we have taken in 2021 to reduce our GHG emissions, and our plans to continue reducing emissions in 2022 and beyond.

Emission Reductions: Actions & Plans

A. Stationary Sources (e.g. buildings, power generation)

- Complete boiler upgrade at Nusatsum Elementary School.
- Continue lighting upgrades, including shift to LED and other efficient options where possible.

B. Mobile Sources (e.g. fleet vehicles, off-road/portable equipment)

Purchase of two new fuel-efficient school buses to replace two outdated models.

C. Paper Consumption

- Reducing paper consumption by shifting to digital forms and storage wherever possible.
- Currently investigating a new component to our payroll system which would greatly reduce paper consumption.
- Seek supplier able to provide paper with a higher percentage of recycled content.

The Organization hereby agrees that, in exchange for the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy (the Ministry) ensuring that these offsets are retired on the Organization's behalf, the Organization will pay within 30 days, the associated invoice to be issued by the Ministry in an amount equal to \$25 per tonne of offsets retired on its behalf plus GST.
