Interim Forest Revenue Sharing Agreement
(The “Agreement”)

Amendment Agreement #6

WHEREAS:

- A. The parties entered into the Agreement on May 14, 2014.
- B. The parties amended this agreement on May 11, 2017, for the purpose of extending the term and revenue sharing to March 31, 2018.
- C. The parties amended this agreement on March 13, 2018, for the purpose of extending the term and revenue sharing to March 31, 2019.
- D. The parties amended this agreement on March 27, 2019, for the purpose of extending the term and revenue sharing to March 31, 2020.
- E. The parties amended this agreement on March 26, 2020, for the purpose of extending the term and revenue sharing to March 31, 2021.
- F. The parties amended this agreement on March 22, 2021, for the purpose of extending the term and revenue sharing to March 31, 2022.
- G. The parties wish to amend the Agreement as set out in this Amendment Agreement #6 for the purpose of extending the term and revenue sharing to March 31, 2023.

THEREFORE:

The parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. Section 10.1 is amended to read as follows:

The Term of this Agreement commences on the Effective Date, and unless terminated earlier in accordance with any of the provisions hereof, will end on March 31, 2023.

- 2. Appendix B Section 3.2 is amended to add the following subsections:

3.2.8 2022/23 BC Fiscal Year: 40 percent;


- 3. Appendix B Section 3.3 is amended to add the words “and 2022/23” following all references to “BC Fiscal Years 2014/15 and 2015/16”.

In all other respects the Agreement remains the same.
