Technical Details

GitLab releases patches for vulnerabilities in dedicated security releases. There are two types of security releases: a monthly, scheduled security release, released a week after the feature release (which deploys on the 3rd Thursday of each month), and ad-hoc security releases for critical vulnerabilities. In addition, the issues detailing each vulnerability are made public on our <u>issue tracker</u> 30 days after the release in which they were patched.

These vulnerabilities are rated as an overall **High** Severity.
