




Figure 3: Softwood Lumber Export Value










Figure 4: Softwood Lumber Export Value -12-Month Moving Sum






Figure 13: Exchange Rate US\$/C\$




Figure 16: Pulp Export Quantity











Figure 17: Pulp Export Quantity -12-Month Moving Sum
