
EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 27 MAY 1974

Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation Pursuant to the of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Covernor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1)No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Golden and Slocan Mining Divisions, Kootenay Land District; in the period commencing on the date of approval of this Order and terminating March 1, 1976:

> Commencing at the most easterly point on the boundary of St. Mary's Alpine Park; being a point on the southerly boundary of the watershed of Skookumchuck Creek; thence in a general easterly and southeasterly direction along the said boundary to the summit of Sawtooth Peak; thence due east to the 6400 foot contour line; thence easterly, northeasterly and westerly along the said 6400 foot contour line which runs westerly of Buhl Creek and southerly of Skookumchuck Creek to the northerly boundary of Lot 4592; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary of Lot 4592 to the easterly boundary thereof; thence northerly along the said easterly boundary of Lot 4592, a distance of 40 chains more or less to the southerly boundary of the watershed of an unnamed creek which flows easterly into Skookumchuck Creek; thence westerly along the said boundary to the easterly boundary of the watershed of Alton Creek; thence northerly along the said easterly boundary of the watershed of Alton Creek and continuing northerly along the easterly boundaries of the watersheds of those unnamed creeks flowing westerly into Findlay Creek to a point lying 8.5 miles South 15° 30' West of the summit of Earn Mountain; thence northeasterly in a straight line to the said summit of Barn Mountain; thence northwesterly in a straight line to the summit of Mount Earl Grey; thence southwesterly in a straight line to the summit of Red Top Mountain; thence southwesterly in a straight line to the summit of Blockhead _Mountain, being a point on the northerly boundary of the watershed

of Hamill Creek; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary of the watershed of Hamill Creek to a point due east of the most easterly southeast corner of Lot 825; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the summit of Comb Mountain being a point on the northerly boundary of the watershed of Clint Creek; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of the watershed of Clint Creek and the southerly boundary of the watershed of Hamill Greek to the summit of Mount Hamill; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the summit of Mount Pambrun, being a point on the westerly boundary of the watershed of Pork Creek; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary of the watershed of Pork Creek to the northerly boundary of the watershed of Fry Creek; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary of the watershed of Fry Creek to the confluence of Fry Creek and Carney Creek; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the summit of Mount Tyrell, being a point on the northeasterly boundary of the watershed of Clute Creek; thence southeasterly along the northeasterly boundaries of the watersheds of Clute Creek and Campbell Creek to the westerly boundary of the watershed of St. Mary River; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of the watershed of the main stream of St. Mary River to a point lying North 74° East of the summit of Mount Loki; thence northeasterly in a straight line to the intersection of the middleline of Dewar Greek with the westerly boundary of Lot 4592; thence due east in a straight line to the westerly boundary of St. Mary's Alpine Park; thence northerly, easterly and southerly along the westerly, northerly and easterly boundaries of St. Mary's Alpine Park to the aforesaid most easterly point thereon, being the point of commencement.

and

A strip of land 40 chains in parallel width bounded on the west by the easterly boundary of Lot 5367 and on the east by the confluence of Fry Creek and Carney Creek and lying within the boundaries drawn parallel to and perpendicularly distant 20 chains on each side of the middle line of Fry Creek:

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
