1.07.3 POLICY STATEMENT

- (1) Volunteers in the following five categories; Search and Rescue; PEP Air Service; Emergency Radio Communications; Emergency Social Services; and Road Rescue will be recognized annually for their service.
- (2) One volunteer from any category will be will be recognized for a Lifetime Achievement award.

1.07.4 CONDITIONS/RESPONSIBILITIES

- (1) To be eligible for an annual recognition award, volunteers must:
 - a. Have in the past and/or present performed outstanding long service or performed with dedication, personal sacrifice or excellence and distinction.
 - b. Be nominated as a candidate for the annual recognition award. Any EMBC recognized person or organization is eligible to submit nominations.
