- without limiting the generality of section 9.5 of the Program Terms and Condition, consent to the BRMB disclosing all personal
  information that I/the applicant provides to the BRMB and the BRMB collects about me/ the applicant to other provincial or
  federal government ministries or municipal governments that are offering any assistance whatsoever as a result of the wildfire for
  the purpose of verifying the information provided and for the purpose of coordinating the assistance provided. This consent is
