Both Emergency Management BC (EMBC) TEAMS and

BC Wildfire Service (BCWS) TEAMS use employees from

other ministries to amplify staffing levels during activations in the event of disasters. Both programs pay for training, overtime, and travel expenses.



### **EMBC TEAMS**

**EMBC TEAMS** are deployed to the **Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centres and the Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre** to co-ordinate support for communities impacted by the emergency or disaster, and to maintain overall situational awareness to enable informed decision-making.

## **BCWS TEAMS**

BCWS TEAMS work in camps, zones and fire centres, supporting all aspects of wildfire response through our Provincial and Regional Coordination Centres.
