



Resource Management Zones

Manages Crown lands consistently with the historic pattern of agriculture and settlement. Other resource development and enhancement activities which are compatible

Manages for development of resources such as timber and minerals while minimizing impact on other resource values.

Manages with specific strategies to integrate a wide array

Manages for the conservation of one or more resource values such as habitat, recreation, scenery and community watersheds while still enabling resource development activities. There are two sub-categories related to
