Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

no person shall locate upon and no free miner shall stake on (1) any of the lands within the following described area in the Vancouver Mining Division, Group 1 New Westminster Land District:

Commencing at a point on the westerly limit of the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority right-of-way surveyed as Lot 6641, said point being 57 chains due north and 31.5 chains more or less due east of the northeast corner of Lot 1025; thence due west 20 chains; thence due north 21 chains; thence due east 19.5 chains more or less to the aforesaid westerly limit of Lot 6641; thence in a general southerly direction along the said westerly limit of Lot 6641 to the aforesaid point of commencement;

upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in the right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall locate upon and no free miner shall stake on such lands;
