

2021 PSO Climate Change Accountability Report

Organization: Board of Education School District #46 (Sunshine Coast)

Declaration statement: This Climate Change Accountability Report for the period January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 summarizes our emissions profile, the total offsets to reach net-zero emissions, the actions we have taken in 2021 to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions and our plans to continue reducing emissions in 2022 and beyond.

Overview:

- Added 2 100 kW pv solar arrays to 2 elementary schools in 2021
- Added 4 EV charging stations in 2021
- LED lighting retrofit Elphinstone Secondary School

Plans for 2022 and onward:

- Investigate feasibility of installing air source heat pumps as primary heating source for hydronic heating systems
- Add additional pv solar arrays
- Replacing fleet vehicles with more efficient vehicles and EV where possible
- Continue to look for ways to "electrify" HVAC systems to reduce CO2 emissions
- Regular review of BMS to ensure operational efficiency of HVAC systems

- ii. Emissions and offset investment amounts will be validated by CAS prior to distributing invoices.
- iii. "Grand Total Offsets to be Retired" have been rounded up to a whole number (no decimal places) before multiplying by \$25

Retirement of Offsets:

In accordance with the requirements of the Climate Change Accountability Act and Carbon Neutral Government Regulation, the Board of Education School District #46 (Sunshine Coast) (the Organization) is responsible for arranging for the retirement of the offsets obligation reported above for the 2021 calendar year, together with any adjustments reported for past calendar years (if applicable). The Organization hereby agrees that, in exchange for the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy (the Ministry) ensuring that these offsets are retired on the Organization's behalf, the Organization will pay within 30 days, the associated invoice to be issued by the Ministry in an amount equal to \$25 per tonne of offsets retired on its behalf plus GST.
