than the growing of forest crops;

And whereas the withdrawal of the aforementioned lands together with any lands previously withdrawn does not diminish the productive capacity of the Licence area to the extent provided in Clause 10 of the Tree Farm Licence;

Therefore pursuant to subsection (14) of Section 36 of the Forest Act and Clause 10 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 1 the following lands are hereby withdrawn from the lands described in Schedule "B" of the Tree Farm Licence Number 1, that is to say all that parcel or tract of land being more particularly shown in bold black on the sketch attached hereto and described as follows:

"Commencing at a point 50 chains South and 80 chains East of South-West corner of Lot 603; thence North 200 feet; thence in a South-Easterly direction along High Water Mark of the Skeena River; thence West 200 feet to point of commencement containing approximately .92 acres.

and the said lands so withdrawn are and shall be henceforth no longer subject to or form any part of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 1.


