## Extraordinary Load Travel Conditions

The pilot car requirements, travel times and information contained in this document are to be used to provide guidance to carriers in anticipating travel conditions when planning for an extraordinary load move. Please note, the conditions for any approval may vary based on dimensions, weights, and/or transportation management plans.
