

By Authority of Section 105(1)(b) of the Forest Practices Code of British Columbia Act, and having determined that certain recreation resources within the subject Provincial Forest lands are in need of protection, I hereby order (or declare) that, effective October 1, 1998, the following restrictions and prohibitions apply, as described to the area shown on the attached map.

The Keystone Standard Basin Local Resource Use Plan area is closed to all motor vehicle use between the periods June 15 to November 15 of each year.

This order remains in force until further notice.
