Amendments to the Forest and Range Agreement (the Agreement) between Upper Nicola Band and the Government of British Columbia dated February 10, 2005

The Upper Nicola Band and the Government of British Columbia hereby agree to the amendments of section 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 of the Agreement.

Sections 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 are amended to read as follows:

3.1.1

After the execution of this Agreement by the Parties, the Minister of Forests will invite the Upper Nicola Band to apply for a nonreplaceable forest licence ("the Kamloops uplift licence opportunity") in accordance with Section 47.3 of the Forest Act to harvest a total of up to 36,751 cubic meters over a 2-year term in the Kamloops Timber Supply Area.

3.1.2

After the execution of this Agreement by the Parties, and after the Minister has determined that sufficient volume of timber is available for disposition to Upper Nicola Band as a result of the implementation of the Forestry Revitalization Act, the Minister will invite Upper Nicola Band to apply under section 47.3 of the Forest Act for a non-replaceable forest licence (the "Merritt licence opportunity") for a total of up to 47,004 cubic meters over a 5-year term in the Merritt Timber Supply Area and for a non-replaceable forest licence (the "Okanagan licence opportunity") for a total of up to 36,000 cubic meters over a 5-year term in the Okanagan Timber Supply Area.
