CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF PERCIVAL WILLIE

VANCOUVER – The inquest into the death of Percival Willie has been scheduled. On Jan. 3, 2008, Terrace RCMP attended a residence and Mr. Willie was found in medical distress. Emergency medical services attended, but despite medical attention he died.

The inquest is scheduled for Sept. 22-24, 2008. Presiding coroner Marj Paonessa and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
