
During these first years,

shows how the preschool years are the MOST ACTIVE PERIODS of brain development, and most sensitive to development opportunities.





Investments in a child during these EARLY YEARS
PAY DIVIDENDS to society and the economy THEIR WHOLE LIFE
THROUGH including in the form of savings to the healthcare, education, justice, and social service systems.

In fact, some economists project that INVESTMENTS IN EARLY CHILDHOOD provide more return on investment than formal education or job training — one study suggests investments in children aged 0–3 produces a benefit of 1 (Heckman, goo.gl/SDHnXh)

There's an infinite number of ways to help young children develop, and everyone has a role to play. THE GOOD NEWS IS that we're learning more each day about how best to invest in that WINDOW OF OPPORTUNITY.
