Commencing at the most westerly northwest corner of Indian Reserve
No. 6 (Ain), Queen Charlotte District; thence north 30° west 120 chains,
more or less, to a point on the 200 ft. contour of elevation above sea
level that surrounds Ian Lake; thence generally southwesterly, westerly,
northeasterly and southerly around said contour to a point 136 chains north
and 8 chains west of the said most westerly northwest corner of Indian Reserve
No. 6; thence south 40° east 136 chains, more or less, to the shore of Massett
Inlet; thence southwesterly along the natural boundary of said shore to the
most easterly boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 6; thence northerly,
