CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF MICHAEL KELLY KURASH

VICTORIA – The Coroner's inquest into the death of Michael Kelly Kurash has been scheduled. On Oct. 17, 2006, Mr. Kurash was arrested by the Saanich Police. After he was released, Mr. Kurash was found unresponsive at his home. Despite medical treatment, he died.

The inquest is scheduled for Aug. 13-15, 2007. Presiding coroner Beth Larcombe and a five-person jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
